Niello is an etching used in decorating in black on silver and copper (and sometimes gold) that is somewhat related to champlevé work except that the effect is metallic rather than vitreous. Here the design of a court recital is engraved in exquisite detail into the fused copper and silver plates, the indented portions originally filled with a black matte alloy and became fused in the grooves creating the contrasting design

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with ball finials, the surface hand painted with floral motifs in tones of coral and blue

Von Herkomer was knighted in 1907 and died in 1914. His work is represented in the National Portrait Gallery in London.
